PLANTING AND CARING FOR YOUR WILDFLOWER PATCH  
PARK CITY NURSERY'S WILDFLOWER BLENDS**

- 1) Eliminate existing weeds and unwanted vegetation in the desired planting area. This can be accomplished through weed control chemicals and/or tilling the area several times.
- 2) Amending the soil with any combination of these: Compost, Mulch, additional Black Topsoil, Gypsum, and a Seed-Starter formula will increase your germination rate. The better the soil, the more success. In our mountain climate, plants need all the advantages we can give them.
- 3) Using a rake, loosen the soil to create small furrows for the seeds to lay in.
- 4) Broadcast seed with a spreader for a more even distribution, or by hand. Use coverage estimates recommended on the tag. 1# covers @ 2,000 square feet.
- 5) Water in gently and thoroughly 2-3 times daily until it germinates. *2-8 weeks depending on the temperature and when the seed is sown.* The combination of heat and water will make seed germinate quicker. If Spring and Summer temperatures are low, it will take longer to germinate.

**PATIENCE, PATIENCE, PATIENCE**

- 6) Continue watering daily. Do Not Over Water or Under Water. After seed germinates, watering schedule can be reduced to every other day and eventually even less frequently.
- 7) IF weeds are eliminated throughout the Summer and Fall, it will create a healthier environment for your Park City Nursery Wildflowers to flourish. More space for flowers, less space for unwanted plant material.
