### PLANTS THAT ATTRACT AND PROTECT BIRDS "BIRDSCAPING"

Birds are attracted to bright colors, fruits and berries. Areas with dense foliage, evergreen, water and shade appeal to them at this elevation. Due to the shortness of our growing season, the few berries that are produced will likely be eaten by our feathered friends before you can get them yourself!

Birds also need winter cover. You can create bird sanctuaries by using a combination of any of these varieties designed to suit your site.

Bird houses and bird feeders are also key to you "Birdscape". Strategically placed they can provide hours of entertainment!

Black Chokeberry	<i>Aronia Melanocorpa</i>	1/4" dark berry
Big Sage	<i>Artemisia tridenta</i>	Winter cover
Cotoneaster, Peking	<i>Cotoneaster acutifolia</i>	Black fall fruit
Dogwood Red Oiser	<i>Cornus sericea</i>	Green berry
Rocky Mtn. Juniper	<i>Juniper</i>	Pea size, bluish berries
Honeysuckle	<i>Lonicera</i>	Bright red summer berries
Creeping Oregon Grape	<i>Mahonia repens</i>	Blue fruit late summer
Flowering Crab	<i>Malus</i>	Assorted fruit and sizes
Spruce	<i>Picea pungens</i>	Winter cover
Mayday Tree	<i>Prunus padus</i>	Small black fruit
Nanking Cherry	<i>Prunus tomentosa</i>	Scarlet early summer
Chokecherry	<i>Prunus virginiana</i>	Dark, edible fruit
Columnar Buckthorn	<i>Phamnus columnaris</i>	Red-black berries through summer
Golden Currant	<i>Ribes aureum</i>	Late summer fruit
Red Lake Currant	<i>Ribes</i>	Bright red summer berries
Roses		Rose hips in summer- winter cover
Elderberry	<i>Sambucus</i>	Black-blue in summer
Buffaloberry	<i>Shepherdia argentia</i>	Sour orange fruit
Mountain Ash	<i>Sorbus acuparia</i>	Orange berry
Common Snowberry	<i>Symphoricarpus 'alba'</i>	White, late summer- fall
Arrowwood	<i>Viburnum dentadum</i>	Wet soil, blue-black berries, wildlife
American Cranberry	<i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	Scarlet berries, summer
Wentworth Cranberry	<i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	Heavy fruiting variety
